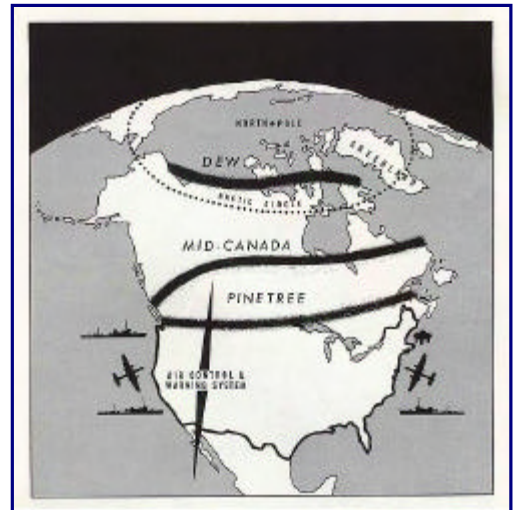

Summer Activities Offered Out of the Hotel Captain Cook

- **Glacier and Wildlife cruises out of Seward and Whittier**
Preferred companies out of Whittier are Phillips Cruises and Tours and Prince William Sound Cruises and Tours. Seward preferred companies are Major Marine Tours and Kenai Fjord Tours. Seward is known for an amazing display of wildlife and some glaciers while Whittier is well known for an abundance of glaciers and wildlife. Tours out of Whittier last about 4.5 hours and out of Seward anywhere between 3-8 hours depending on tour selection
- **Flight Seeing Out of Anchorage**
You can fly out of Anchorage on a small plane and visit Knik Glacier, Mt. McKinley, and other remote areas for bear viewing and fly-out fishing trips. The preferred companies are Regal Air and Rust's flying service. Each company will provide complimentary shuttle service from the hotel to Lake Hood and then back to the hotel after the trip.
- **Summer Glacier Dog Sledding**
This trip is with Alpine Air and is located in Girdwood 45 minutes south of Anchorage. This trip is one of the most popular tours with our guests. Guests will enjoy an amazing helicopter ride into the awe inspiring Chugach Mountains and then land on a snow covered glacier. Once on the glacier you will get a once in a lifetime opportunity to drive your own Iditarod sled dog team.
- **Private Guided Trips**
Salmon Berry Tours is a great option for guests who don't have transportation but still want to enjoy the beauty outside of Anchorage. Salmon Berry Tours' most popular trip is called the Glacier Turn. This trip includes a scenic tram ride at the Alyeska resort with lunch, a stop at the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center and a one-hour boat ride to view the Portage Glacier.
- **Other Possible Trips**
 - Halibut Fishing out of Seward or Whittier
 - Salmon Fishing in the Kenai Peninsula
 - Kayaking in Whittier/ Seward
 - Whitewater rafting out of Hope
 - ATV Trips
 - Local bicycle rentals to bike along the coastal trail or downtown

These activities include the Anchorage Museum of History and Art, Alaska Native Heritage Center, Local Trolley Tours of Downtown Anchorage, The Alaska Zoo, Golfing in the midnight sun, and the Downtown Markets and shopping.

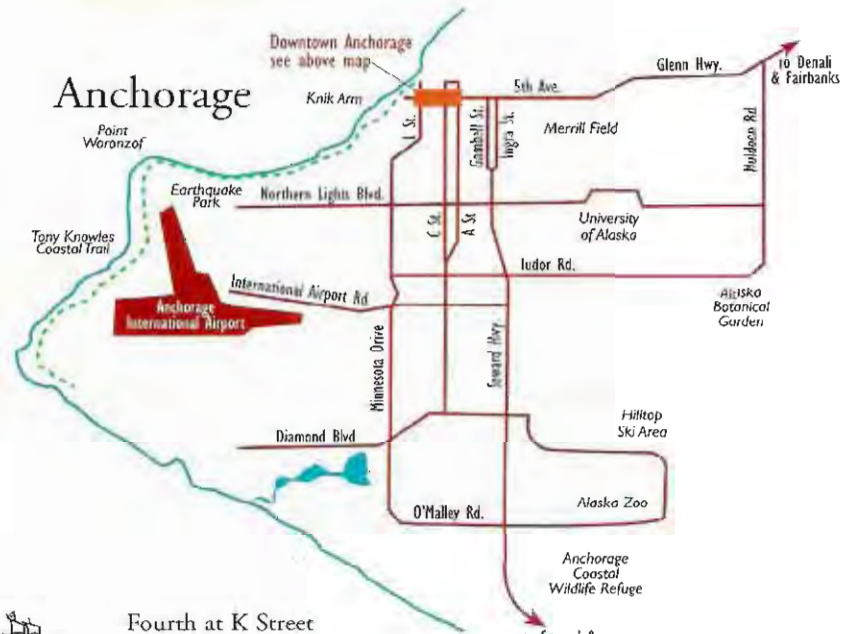
